Her presence on Block Island shows her support and CFC's willingness to support us.



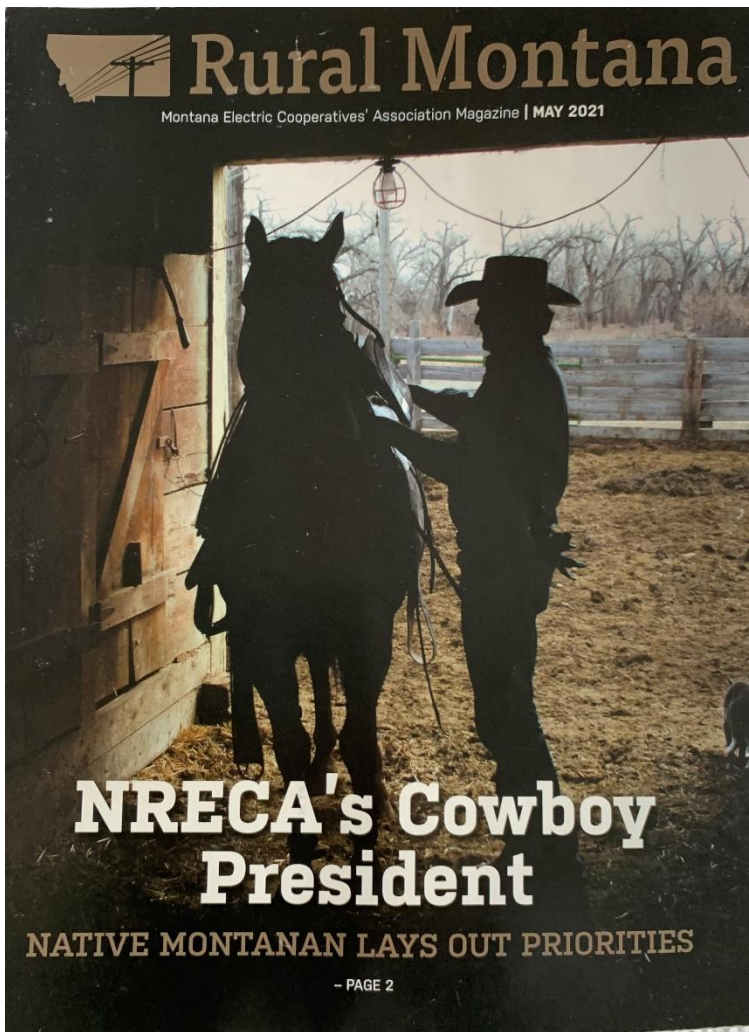


## **Chris Christensen Past-NRECA President**
